

ĐỀ CƯƠNG ÔN TẬP KHẢO SÁT MÔN TIẾNG ANH

Khoa Ngoại Ngữ xin thông báo về phương thức và nội dung kiểm tra khảo sát môn Tiếng Anh cho sinh viên các khối lớp không chuyên ngữ khoá K11 như sau:

A. Phương thức kiểm tra:

- Sinh viên dự kiểm tra khảo sát nội dung tiếng Anh tổng quát ở cả hai nội dung Đọc-Viết và Nói với lượng kiến thức tương đương trình độ B (Intermediate Level)
- Thí sinh làm phần thi Đọc- Viết trên 1 bài thi có độ dài tương đương 60 phút.
- Thí sinh sẽ làm bài thi Nói trong cùng buổi thi ngay sau khi kết thúc bài thi Đọc- Viết.
